4. KISSY KISSY FINGERS (rhyme)

Kissy kissy fingers, kissy kissy toes,
Kissy kissy baby, on your kissy nose.
I love to kiss your fingers, I love to kiss your toes,
I love to kiss my baby, on your kissy nose.



5. LOVE MY BABY (Song)

Love my baby, Yes I do
 Love my baby, Yes I do
 Love my baby, Yes I do
 And I'm going to give a big hug (kiss, tickle, etc.) to you

6. THE MOON IS ROUND (Rhyme)

The moon is round as round can be (draw circle around baby's face)
 Two eyes (gently touch eyebrows)
 A nose (gently touch nose)
 And a mouth like me! (touch your mouth and baby's mouth)

7. I LOVE YOUR TOES (Song)

Everybody knows I love your toes
 Everybody knows I love your toes
 I love your feet
 I love your hands
 I love your mouth and your nose
 But everybody knows I love your toes

8. YOU ARE MY BEAUTIFUL BABY (Song - by Adrianna Karka)

You are my beautiful baby (baby's name)
 You are my beautiful boy/girl
 You are my beautiful baby (baby's name)
 The most beautiful boy/girl in the world.

9. SKINNAMARINK (Song)

Skinamarinky dinky dink
 Skinamarinky doo...I love you
 Skinamarinky dinky dink
 Skinamarinky doo...I love you
 I love you in the morning and in the afternoon
 I love you in the evening and underneath the moon
 Skinamarinky dinky dink
 Skinamarinky doo...I love you

New verse ...
 I love you when you're smilin'
 I love you when you're glad

10. SHE DIDN'T DANCE (Song)

She/he didn't dance, dance, dance
 She didn't dance at all today
 She didn't dance, dance, dance
 No, nor yesterday
 So dance her/him up and up and up and up
 And dance her up in the sky
 So dance her up and up and up and up
 And she'll be down by and by.

11. ROUND AND ROUND THE GARDEN (Rhyme)

Round and round the garden (draw circles on baby's hand or tummy)
 Goes the teddy bear
 One step! ... BIG PAUSE
 Two steps! ... BIG PAUSE
 Tickle you under there! (tickle under baby's arm)

12. SLOWLY SLOWLY (Song)

Slowly, slowly, very slowly (walk fingers slowly up baby's legs and tummy)
 Crawls the garden snail
 Slowly, slowly, very slowly
 Up the garden trail

Quickly, quickly, very quickly (make fingers run quickly up baby's body)
 Runs the little mouse
 Quickly, quickly, very quickly
 Right in to its BIG PAUSE ... HOUSE!" (tickle under baby's arm)

13. A SMOOTH ROAD (Rhyme)

(Put baby on your legs facing you)

A smooth road, a smooth road, a smooth road, a smooth road ...
 A bumpy road, etc. ... (bounce baby with your knees)
 A windy road, etc. ... (move baby in circular motion)
 A rough road, etc. ... (faster bouncing)
 And aaaaaaahaaaaa BIG PAUSE.....HOLE! (lower baby gently between your knees)



14. CLAP, CLAP, CLAP OUR HANDS (Song)

Clap, clap, clap our hands (depending on baby's age, help her clap or let her do it herself)
Clap our hands together
Clap, clap, clap our hands, clap our hands together.

Stamp, stamp, stamp our feet, etc.
Shake, shake, shake our heads etc.

15. MY TOES MY KNEES MY SHOULDERS MY HEAD (Tune: Here we go 'round the Mulberry Bush)

My toes, my knees, my shoulders, my head
My toes, my knees, my shoulders, my head
My toes, my knees, my shoulders, my head
Come on let's clap our hands.

Instructions:
Sing once through VERY SLOWLY
Second time - a little faster
Third time - as fast as you can!

16. THESE ARE BABY'S FINGERS (Rhyme)

These are baby's [insert name] fingers (touch baby's fingers, etc)
These are [baby's name] toes
This is baby's belly button
Round and round it goes (run fingers around)

17. MY GRANDFATHER'S CLOCK (Rhyme)

(With arms straight out, move like a clock)
My grandfather's clock goes TICK, TOCK, TICK, TOCK ... 6 times (slowly, in a deep voice)
The kitchen clock goes Tick, Tock, Tick, Tock ... 6 times (a little faster in a normal voice)
And, Mummy's/Daddy's little watch goes ticky, ticky, ticky, ticky, ticky, ticky! (really fast in a high voice)

18. SHAKE IT BABY SHAKE IT (Tune: She's going to Kentucky)

Shake it baby shake it
Shake it up and down
Shake your little rattle
And make a 'ch-kuh' sound

New verses ...make up your own!
Shake your little bottle and make a 'gluppy' sound...
Shake your piece of paper and make a 'scrunchy' sound

19. THIS IS THE WAY WE WASH OUR HANDS (Tune: Mulberry Bush)

This is the way we wash our hands,
Wash our hands, wash our hands,
This is the way we wash our hands
So early in the morning.

Other verses ... add your own!
Brush our hair...
Put on our shoes...
Kiss our (baby's name)



20. CHANGING DIAPERS (Tune: Frere Jacques. Words: Adapted by a parent)

Changing diapers, changing diapers
 So much fun, so much fun
 You're no longer stinky, you're no longer stinky
 Nice clean bum, nice clean bum!

21. HUMPTY DUMPTY (Rhyme)

Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall (bounce baby softly on knees)
 Humpty Dumpty had a greeeeeeeaaaaaaat... FALL (drop baby between knees)
 All the kings horses and all the kings men
 Couldn't put Humpty together again!
 So, he climbed, back, up, on, the wall!

22. SLICE SLICE (Rhyme)

Slice, slice (make slicing movement on baby's tummy)
 The bread looks nice
 Spread, spread some butter on my bread (spread hand over baby's tummy)
 Jam on top to make you sweet (stroke baby's head)
 And now you're ready for me toooooooooooo EAT!
 Yum, yum, yum, yum, yum, yum. (pretend to nibble baby's neck or tummy)

23. ZOOM ZOOM ZOOM (Song)

Zoom, zoom, zoom, we're going to the moon (with baby on floor - rock back and forth)
 Zoom, zoom, zoom, we're going to the moon
 If you want to take a trip,
 Climb aboard my rocket ship (lift baby onto your knees)
 Zoom, zoom, zoom, we're going to the moon
 5(slow right down) ... 4 3 21 (wait for it)
 BLAST OFF! (lift baby up in the air)

24. POPCORN POPCORN (Rhyme)

Popcorn, popcorn (with baby facing you, gently pull his arms back and forth)
 Put it in the pan
 Shake it up, shake it up (bounce baby)
 BAM(slow down) BAM (wait for it) BAM! (lift baby in the air!)



25. KNOCK ON THE DOOR (Rhyme)

Knock on the door (gently tap baby's forehead)
 Ring the bell (twirl a strand of baby's hair)
 Peek in (touch baby's lower eyelid)
 Lift the latch (touch baby under the nose)
 Walk inside (gently walk fingers on baby's lips)
 Go downstairs and eeeeeaaaaaat (wait for it) APPLES! (tickle baby's tummy)

26. YOU ROCK AND YOU ROCK (Song)

(Hold baby on your lap and do the various actions)
 You rock and you rock and you rock and you ...STOP (freeze like a statue for 2 secs)
 You rock and you rock and you rock and you ...STOP
 You rock and you rock and you rock and you ...STOP
 You rock and you rock and you ... (wait for it)...STOP!
 You bounce ...
 You wave ...
 You stomp ...etc.

27. LET'S TAKE A WALK (Song)

(Sing this song while you take your baby on a discovery walk - in your arms, or in the stroller)
 Let's take a walk, take a walk, take a walk,
 To see what we can see
 Let's take a walk, take a walk, take a walk
 To see what we can see ... (Sing twice through)
 (At the end of singing, stop and let your baby explore whatever you've stopped in front of)

28. WHERE IS THUMBKIN? (Tune: Frere Jacques)

Where is thumbkin? (both hands behind your back)
 Where is thumbkin?
 Here I am (bring out one thumb)
 Here I am (bring out the other thumb)
 How are you this morning (make thumbs 'talk' to each other)
 Very well I thank you
 Run and hide (put one thumb behind your back)
 Run and hide (put other thumb behind your back)



29. HERE WE GO TO GRANMA'S (Tune: Here we go sodeeyo)

 Here we go to grandma's all day long

30. SKINNAMARINK (Song)

(New verse adapted for bedtime routine)
 Skinnamarinky, dinky dink, skinnamarinky doo, etc.
 I love you in the bath tub
 With soap upon your head
 I love you when you're bundled up
 And on your way to bed ...
 Skinnamarinky dinky dink, etc.

31. CRISS CROSS APPLESAUCE (Rhyme)

Criss Cross (draw big "x" on baby's front or back)
 Apple (tap baby on one shoulder) Sauce (tap other shoulder)
 Spiders crawling up your back/tummy (run your fingers up your baby's tummy)
 One here (wiggle baby's right ear), One there (wiggle baby's left ear)
 Spiders crawling in your hair (run fingers over baby's head)
 Cool breeze (blow gently on baby's neck),
 Tight squeeze (hug)
 Now you've got the shiverree! (tickle baby's shoulders)

32. SWING ME OVER THE OCEAN (Lullaby)

Swing me over the ocean,
 Swing me over the sea,
 Swing me over the garden wall
 And swing me home for tea.
 Swing me over the treetops,
 Swing me over the zoo
 Swing me over the garden wall
 And swing me home to you
